What This Role Is About

We're looking for a guitarist who enjoys working with young people (Year 7 – 10) and sharing the experience of making music to teach Class 7 – 10 in small groups.

What You'll Do

- Teach four 45-minute small-group guitar sessions on Wednesdays during the school term.
- Support students in developing technical skill and musical confidence.
- Work collaboratively with the Music Teacher and other instrumental tutors.
- Assist students preparing for performances and school events.
- Contribute to a positive and engaging music program.

- Strong guitar skills and musical knowledge
- Experience teaching music to young people or small groups (desirable)
- Current Working With Children Check
- Strong communication and collaboration skills

- You enjoy teaching in small groups where relationships matter

Role Structure

This role includes **four** 45-minute guitar sessions on Wednesdays between 11:00 am and 2:35 pm during the school term.

There is also the potential for this position to be combined with a Band Assistant role on Mondays, supporting student ensembles and performances.

Applicants interested in combining both roles are encouraged to indicate this in their application.
