The Role

As a Science and or Math Teacher, you'll teach a mix of Main Lessons and subject-specific classes across the secondary years. This immersive teaching model allows students to engage deeply with academic, scientific and practical learning.

- **Main Lessons** are extended teaching blocks, usually taught each morning over several weeks, allowing students and teachers to explore a particular mathematical or scientific concept in much greater depth. In Science, this may involve observation, experimentation, investigation and discussion; in Mathematics, it allows time to develop concepts carefully, explore patterns and applications, and build genuine understanding rather than simply moving quickly from one topic to the next.
- **Weekly lessons and electives** complement the Main Lessons by providing ongoing development of core knowledge, skills, practical work and problem-solving, while ensuring students are well prepared for the academic demands of the senior years.

Students do not participate in WACE subjects; however, the Steiner curriculum is aligned to the WA Curriculum.
